CHICAGO and WALTHAM, Mass., Oct. 18, 2017 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- The Foundation for Women's Cancer (FWC), the official foundation of the Society of Gynecologic Oncology, and TESARO, Inc. The event features a 5K run and 1 mile walk on Sunday, Nov. 5, along Pennsylvania Avenue, NW in Washington, D.C.

Every five minutes a woman will receive a gynecologic cancer diagnosis in the United States. More than 107,470 women will be diagnosed with a gynecologic cancer and about 31,600 will die from these cancers in 2017. The FWC supports survivors and works to raise awareness and research funding to eradicate gynecologic cancers.

Pre-race programing will begin at 7:30 a.m. at 14th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue NW, with the 5K run starting at 9:30 a.m., followed by the 1 mile walk at 9:45 a.m. FWC anticipates approximately 2,000 participants at this year's event.

The event is led by National Race Co-Chairs Camille Grammer, an endometrial cancer survivor and star on "The Real Housewives of Beverly Hills," who will walk the route with her team, "Camille's Crusaders;" and Wendy Ericsson, a uterine cancer survivor, who also serves as captain of her team "Wendy's Warriors."
