Pre-race programing will begin at 7:30 a.m. at 14th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue NW, with the 5K run starting at 9:30 a.m. The event is led by National Race to End Women's Cancer Co-Chairs Camille Grammer, an endometrial cancer survivor and star on "The Real Housewives of Beverly Hills," who will walk the route with her team, "Camille's Crusaders," and Wendy Ericsson, 2017 "Super Survivor" award recipient and a uterine cancer survivor, who also serves as captain of her team "Wendy's Warriors."
